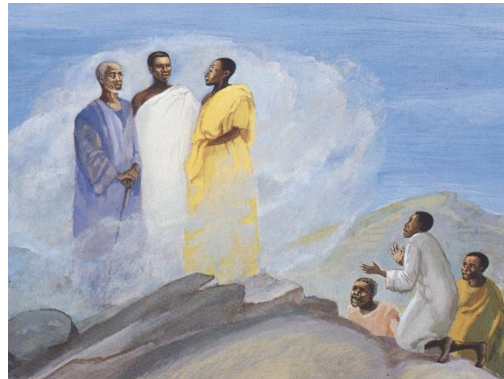
Welcome!

Resource: '30 Days of Prayer for the Muslim World'

The International Mission branch of the LCA have again produced a resource titled 30 Days of Prayer for the Muslim World – '*The Word of God is Not Bound*' to coincide with the Muslim fast month of Ramadan, which began this week. This year, the resource tells the stories of Muslims who have been impacted by the Christian scriptures. The stories will show that the Word of God is not bound to specific geographical locations, or to a specific format. Each story is set in the context of a specific Muslim community that needs your prayers. It is hoped that this prayer guide will inspire people to pray throughout these 30 days that Muslims will encounter the Jesus of Scripture, the spiritual power of the gospel (Rom. 1:16), and the effective work of the Word of God (Heb. 4:12).
