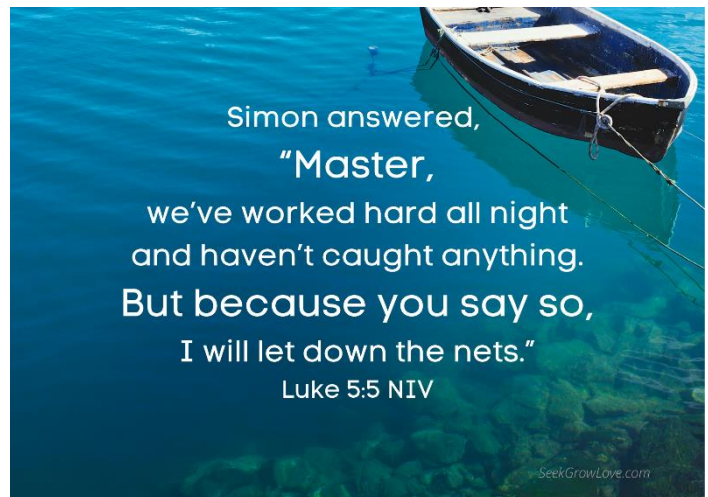
Welcome!

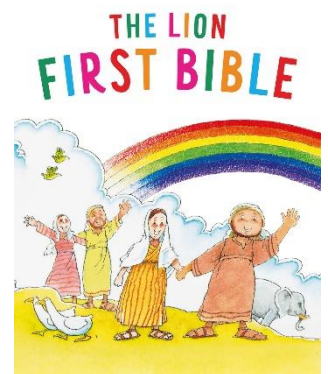
